

CRITERIA FOR THE GOLDEN PHEASANT AWARD

The Golden Pheasant Award is an award presented by the Past Shooter Organization to any Past Shooter or individual in the community whose efforts have made significant contributions to the perpetuation and success of the One Box Pheasant Hunt. The Golden Pheasant Selection Committee consists of the Past President, Vice President and the Executive Secretary and approved by the One Box Board of Directors. Recipients have exhibited many years of loyalty and devotion to the overall success of the One Box Hunt as landowners, guide, host, and help with the registration process.

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** Anyone associated with the Nebraska One Box Pheasant Hunt community whose efforts have made a significant contribution to the continued success of the One Box Pheasant Hunt is eligible for the Golden Pheasant Award.
2. **NOMINATIONS:** Any Past Shooter may nominate a candidate, or candidates, for consideration by the Golden Pheasant Selection Committee. Nominations shall be made to the Executive Secretary of the Past Shooters Board of Directors **by June 30th of each year.**
3. **SELECTION COMMITTEE:** The Golden Pheasant Selection Committee shall consist of the *Past President, Vice President, and the Executive Secretary* of the Past Shooters organization.
4. **SELECTION PROCESS:** The Selection Committee shall meet and select the recipient, or joint recipients, of the Golden Pheasant Award. The Executive Secretary shall **present the recipient, or joint recipients, to the Past Shooters Board of Directors at the September Board meeting for approval by a majority vote of those members present.**
5. **ANNOUNCEMENT:** The Golden Pheasant Award shall be presented by the President of the Past Shooters at the Saturday night Victory Banquet of the annual One Box Pheasant Hunt.
